
# OUR PURPOSE


## "To educate in learning forever"

# WHY WE EXIST



Our school was founded more than 400 years ago through the extraordinary vision and ideals of John Harrison, a citizen and Merchant Taylor of London, who bequeathed a sum of money for the foundation of a "school for teaching, educating and instructing children and youth in the grammar and rules of learning for ever".

The Merchant Taylors' Company dates back to 1327 and is one of the twelve great City Livery Companies. It began as a social and religious fraternity of tailors and linen armourers and was originally an association of citizens controlling the craft of tailoring. Over the years, members' interests have spread into both commerce and philanthropy. It is a flourishing community dedicated to fraternity, education and philanthropy.

Members connect in friendship and mutual support, as they have for centuries.
